Engineering. She will also be a member of the Army ROTC. Grace thoroughly enjoyed her year abroad. She thinks her biggest accomplishment is being able to speak fluent Danish - which she demonstrated and proved to a skeptical Adam O.

During her year she stayed with 3 different host families. She learned a lot about the public transportation, taking a bus and a train to and from school. The Denmark Rotary Club that Grace attended is a morning, breakfast club. The President of the club is a pilot and took Grace up for a spin where she enjoyed the view of the flat terrain that is hard to see from the ground.

Grace described the Danes as 'coconuts'. At first, a hard nut to crack but when you get in they are very sweet! Danes like to party - Graduation being quite an event. Grace showed us the Graduation hats where all your friends bite the visor for good luck. Christmas with candle lighted, LIVE trees and New Year's Eve fireworks are 2 more examples of their party celebrations.

The Euro-tour was another incredible event - 3 weeks on a bus visiting 7 countries! Her final goodbye to Denmark included 40,000 people at a 3 day music festival.

Grace's answer to "What did this experience teach you" ?- "I have learned to always try to have a positive attitude" not to dwell on missing my life and family in Newark but to enjoy all the amazing opportunities I experienced as an exchange student.
