SPEAKER - JACK MAY

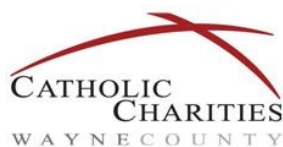


Steve Hallagan introduced our speaker, Jack May who has retired after 33 years from the National Weather Service. It was refreshing not to talk about viruses and the stock market - just the weather! Jack's assignments were in the aviation weather forecasting area. He retired in 2007 and since then he has contributed to the FAA development of Next Gen Weather Concepts. These systems reduce the impact of weather on aviation, making air travel safer and more predictable. Jack was one of three National Weather Service meteorologists stationed in Lake Placid to support the 1980 Winter Olympics. Jack talked to us about sources of weather information. Each table had a paper providing links to some of these sources. Jack has a weather station in his own backyard. He likes to impress his friends being able to make tee times when the skies will be free of rain!
