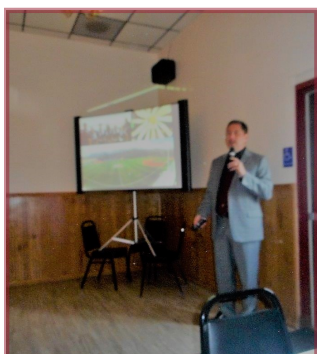

Matt spoke to the club about Newark's strategic Plan and Budget for the coming school year. The High School budget refers to a staffing plan and a spread sheet. In the area of staffing, elementary enrollment is up. They will need a new 6th grade

teacher and a Special Ed teacher. They are also adding an Assistant Principal and an Administrative Intern. Scholastically adding Academic Intervention and a new math program. The High School is promoting a kindness initiative. They are providing Circle Conversations as an alternative to detentions, learning that suspending a student is not productive. This year's budget is \$49 million - pulling 1.1million out of reserve. Good news - Perkins playground received a \$50,000 grant.
