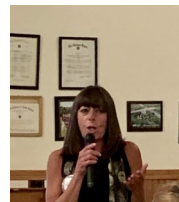


**Adam O.** again is receiving awards for his business endeavors at Marshall Exteriors. They have been listed in the top 100 companies in the Rochester area.

**MELISSA COREIA** is officially an empty nester with her daughter attending the University of Buffalo.

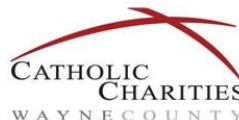
## Wellness Report
