We were happy to have Gail Chambers return with at least one good arm!



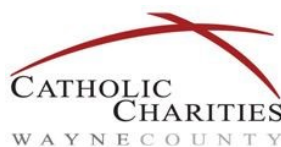
SPEAKER - MATTHEW CAINE

Matthew, Newark's US Postmaster, was introduced by Jim Weiler, Matthew's mentor and former postmaster of Wolcott. Matthew explained that the Postal service is still vital and hires 113,000 veterans. We've all heard "the mail must go through". Mule delivery in the Grand Canyon is proof of that! Ben Franklin was our first Post Master. Then in 1970 the post office became an independent form of government. It is the third largest company behind the government and Walmart. Matthew reminded us it is our CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT TO RECEIVE MAIL. In 2006 the Forever Stamps were introduced - the price to stay forever the same. With E-mail putting a dent into the post business at one point Michael Douglas sent out hand written love letters to help promote the post office. Matthew's informative program helped us to understand and appreciate our local postal service.
