Mott's has 207 acres located on the Lake with a warehouse on site. There are 14 mfg lines, designating 6 for applesauce. They produce 1 million cases per month. One unique item is their multiserve containers for big families. They also make a 5 1/2 % alcohol juice drink that Stu Blodgett generously offered to taste test. Heather's group brings in the apples. Apples grow best in temperate climates - Washington state being #1 and Wayne County #2. They are dependent on weather and bees for pollination - keep up the good work Fred!
