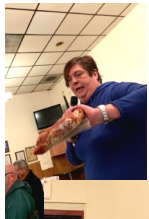

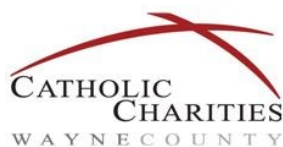


PAM GARDNER announced that the TOYS FOR KIDS collection will be held on December 7th at St Marks.
