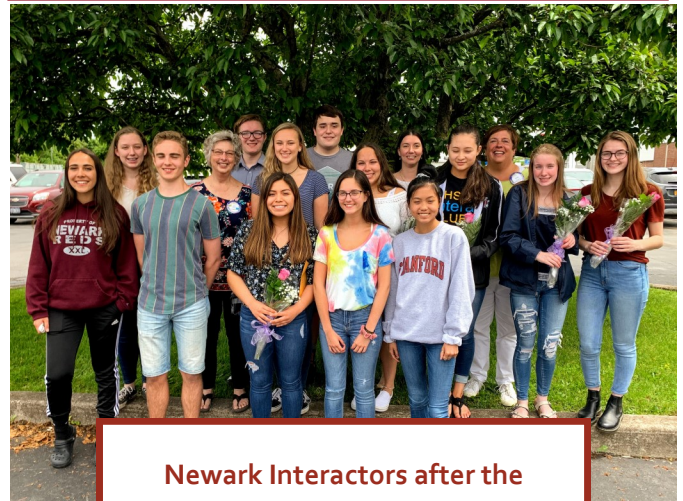


District Changeover Dinner
